**B.Tech Program:** This four-year degree program's minimum credit requirement is 160 credits. The duration of the program is 8 semesters. The students can do additional credits through the open elective of courses, allowing them to develop a broad interdisciplinary knowledge base.

**Hostel Accommodation:** The outstation candidates, admitted to the programs of study of the University will be considered for hostel accommodation as per the rules of the university subject to availability. Grant of admission to the university would not ensure automatic allotment of hostel accommodation which is subject to availability.

#### **Some Frequently Asked Questions**

**Q1: What is the eligibility criterion for admission in B.Tech program at CUH?**

A1: Eligibility criterion for admission in the first year of B.E./B.Tech is the same as JEE- Main 2025.

**Q2: Is there any age limit in the admission Process?**

A2: The age limit is the same as JEE-main.

**Q3: Is the candidate who has compartment in any subject in class 12?**

A3 No.

**Q4: Is there any provision of supernumerary seats (other than approved intake) for admission in B.Tech. program?**

A4 No.

**Q5: Is there a provision of management quota for admission in B.Tech. program?**

A5: No.

**Q6: What is the schedule of the admission process for B.Tech. program?**

A6: Admission will be granted by JOSAA-2025 (<https://josaa.nic.in/>) through 6 rounds. Thereafter, on the remaining/leftover seats, admissions will be granted by CSAB-2025 (<https://csab.nic.in/csab-special/>) through 3 rounds. Further remaining seats will be filled through Open counselling after 20-08-2025 (based on the vacant seat metric and instructions received from JOSAA/CSAB and competent authority).

**Q7: What is the Overall Seat Metrics in Various Category for the admission in B.Tech?**

**Q9: How can I get the information about the open counselling schedule and process?**

A9: It will be available on institute website in B.Tech admission section.

**Q10: Is there any admission through CUET in B.Tech program?**

A10: Admissions are through JOSAA, CSAB. Only in Open counselling, in case of non-availability of JEE-Main appeared candidates, the candidates with CUET (Mathematics and Physics) score will be considered for deciding the merit.

**Q11: Website shows that admissions in CUH are through CUET score as well?**

A11: Institute website does already have notice dated 09-05-2025, that admissions are through JOSAA/CSAB. ([https://www.cuh.ac.in/btech\\_admission.aspx](https://www.cuh.ac.in/btech_admission.aspx)). Students are searching through google or chatGPT or may be at CUET website. As because in 2023, there were 50% B.Tech admissions through CUET in all the departments, so all these sources are showcasing this result upon search and CUET may have not updated their website for the same. Also, other courses in CUH are having admissions through CUET, that's why, it may be.

**Q12: I have taken admission in B.Tech of CUH through JOSAA/CSAB, why document verification is at Central University of Jammu (CUJ) instead of CUH?**

A12: Every year, the counselling authority (JoSAA/CSAB) designates the verifying center for each institute. From 2023 onwards, CUJ serves as the verifying center for online document verification of CUH, while physical document verification for seat confirmation will be conducted at CUH only.

**Q13: What, if I have paid the fee lesser/larger than the institute semester fee of CUH through JOSAA/CSAB?**

A13: It will be refunded to the student or adjusted for next semester fee by the institute. If lesser fee is paid by the candidate, then remaining fee will have to be submitted by the candidate to the institute for seat confirmation.

**Q14: Up to when, the classes will get start at CUH for B.Tech 1<sup>st</sup> Yr?**

A14: Once the online counselling will be completed, the physical reporting with document verification will held in the respective departments (approximately on 20 August 2025) and classes will get started.

**Q15: What is the Fee Structure at CUH for B.Tech 1<sup>st</sup> Yr?**

A15: It is available at UCH website (<https://www.cuh.ac.in/feestructure.aspx>).

**Q16: I will be given temporary residence on the days of open counseling?**

A16: No, candidate and his/her parents have to see for necessary arrangements by themselves.
