- Abstract: 150-300 words Keywords: 4-6

- The front page of the paper should provide Author's Name, Organization, E-Mail Address and Contact Number
- All tables and figures should be numbered and should appear in the corresponding text with captions
- Before submission of full-length paper, all the participants are required to register individually for the seminar
- The Submission of full-length paper in MS-Word will be to the (mail id)
- Paper presenters shall send the PPT at least three days prior to the date of seminar.
