ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Chanakya (375–283 BCE) was an ancient Indian polymath who was active as a teacher, author, strategist, philosopher, economist, jurist, and royal advisor. He is traditionally identified as **Kautilya** or **Vishnugupta**, who authored the ancient Indian political treatise, 'the Arthashastra' a text dated to roughly between the fourth century BCE and the third century CE. As such, he is considered the pioneer of the field. The Arthashastra of Kautilya is one of the most significant and exhaustive treatises on applied philosophy dealing with social, political, economic and cultural life of a civilized society. Apart from stating the methodological principles of theorizing and system building.

It was believed that no nation can be strategically strong until or unless they understand and execute the concepts of Kautilya's Arthashastra i.e., '*Chanakya Niti*'

To understand the different philosophical and ideological aspects of Chanakya in present time and to explore upto what extent this philosopher of India has relevance to lead the different policies for the wellbeing of the entire world and enriching the believe of Bharat (India) as 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam, this seminar is planned.
